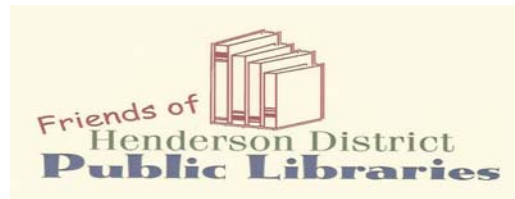

- Friends received initial status as a tax-exempt nonprofit organization from the Internal Revenue Status and Employer Identification Number 88-0463771.
- A model of the new Paseo Verde Library was shown to Friends. The new facility will have space for a Friends bookstore.
- The first fundraiser of Friends was a book sale in conjunction with the City of Henderson Art Fair May 12 and 13, 2001. A notice in the Henderson Home News brought donations of over 5,000 used books for the sale. Friends made \$1,200.00. Mary Dale Deacon coordinated the event; more than 20 volunteers assisted.
