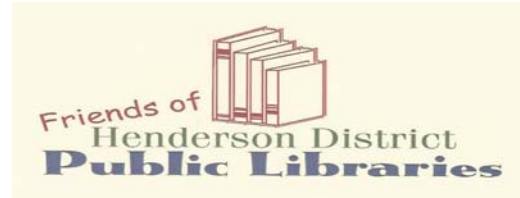

2001-2002 Accomplishments

- Friends provided a booth at the Nevada Library Association Annual Conference. Four authors were showcased. A portion of the book sales was given to Friends.
- The spring book sale at Art Fest took place May 10-12, 2002. Friends co-sponsored the event with the Henderson Rotary Club. Mary Dale Deacon chaired the event that netted \$4,500.
- Friends began plans for three major events in the fall of 2002: bringing the Art Train exhibit to Henderson, hosting the reception at the opening of the Paseo Verde Library, and participating in the Vegas Valley Book Festival.
- Book bags bearing the Friends logo were ordered to sell at Friends events and in the library branches.
- Bob Kasner was elected to replace Jack Childs, deceased, as vice president.
- Friends selected children's books from the used-books donations and donated them to Kids-to-Kids, a program that distributes about 60,000 books per year to children.
- President Ann Barron emphasized the purposes of Friends in an interview for the Henderson Home News: "We put the organization together . . . after seeing the need for the library to have support outside the small tax revenue. Our role is to provide any support we can to enhance the services and the collections the library has."

Note: The by-laws name the Chair of the Henderson Libraries Board as an ex-officio member of the Friends Board, but from 1999-2002 Kathy Jumper served as liaison to work closely with the new group.
